

Arizona Radon Facts



Arizona has been tracking Radon Test results **since 1993** –

The State has 7,000 radon test results: 2.9 pCi/L of air is our average
74% below 4 pCi/L of air
26% above 4pCi/L of air
Maximum level – 55.8 pCi/L

The only way to know if you have elevated Radon Levels is to test your home for Radon
Radon Test Kit are free to homeowners through State’s website: **arra.az.gov**

Radon Legislation in Arizona:

Arizona does not require testers or mitigators to be certified.

Radon Awareness, Education, Testing and Mitigation

- *The educational component is fulfilled through teaching realtor classes, builder’s classes, mitigation classes and other groups that have a special interest in learning more about radon
- *Interact with ten local Health Districts to educate residents about radon and its health effects
- *Attend local home shows, health-fairs
- *Teach Environmental Science students at High Schools and Junior Highs

SIRG Grant:

Arizona has a 60/40 grant, the state has excided the 40% for the last 5 years, this year had a \$20,000 reduction in the grant from EPA.
