If you are taking the NRSB exam for a state license, you must check with your state to make sure you are taking the correct NRSB exam. All exam fees are non-refundable.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- The exams include a virtual live proctor.
- The exams are multiple choice and the examinee should select the single best answer.
- You are permitted one piece of scrap paper and a pen or pencil during the exam.
- There are digital tools available which include a notepad and a calculator. To access them click on the "Tools" button on the top right of the menu bar.
- There is also a check box so you may flag a question for review during or before exiting the exam.

RENEW YOUR CERTIFICATION

To renew your Radon Measurement and/or Radon Mitigation certification you will need to complete the following:

Please Note:

- You are required to use an approved NRSB device



- The NRSB recognizes all ANSI/AARST radon standards.
- An NRSB certificate holder must follow the standards recognized by the state.
- New Advanced Listings to meet ANSI/AARST standards for measurement and mitigation for multi-family housing, schools/daycares, and large buildings.

Developments

- The NRSB recognizes certifications for RMS, RMT, and RRS issued by either the NRPP or by a state licensure program. An NRPP or state radon credentialed individual may transfer their in-kind credential(S) to the NRSB Certification.
- The National Radon Safety Board (NRSB) proudly announces that our exams have been officially approved by the State of New Jersey's Department of Environmental Protection Radon Program. If you are eager to obtain certification as a Radon Measurement Technician/Specialist or Radon Mitigation Specialist, take your exam through NRSB and get certified today."
