**Meeting Purpose:**


Reduce radon-induced lung cancer by strengthening working relationships, program and educational outreach, and communication between industry and agencies within the Southeast Radon Network.

**Meeting Outcomes:**

1. Build professional connections amongst certified radon industry professionals, state and federal agencies representatives that serve the Southeast Radon Network in Region 4.
2. Recognize the purpose, goals, accomplishments, limitations, current efforts, and future directions of the respective partners.
3. Understand the importance and value that state and federal reps have for certified radon industry professionals as partners in advancing evidence-based radon knowledge and policies both to elected officials and consumers (homeowners, developers, and real estate brokers).
4. Certified radon industry professionals recognize the limitations that state and federal reps have within the Southeast Radon Network.
5. Identify ways that state and federal reps can *support* and lift up certified radon industry professionals.
6. Streamline the reporting process between state and certified radon industry professionals that result in reliable bi-annual metrics.
7. Determine a communication mechanism that increases coordination (ex: steering committee at region 4 and state level).
8. Determine what, if any, future engagements need to be organized and by whom (are there program leads and if not, is there a need to identify).
