



# State Policy – Current Developments

- Testing before home sale passed RI Senate, held in RI House
- Testing before home sale AND rentals RE commission draft in MD
- ANSI-AARST Standards in effect in 16 states (100% in 14, one or more in 2)
  - Standards updated in VA
  - Standards update pending in FL
- Regulation through certification laws MD, MO, NY, TN, WI
- Enhanced compliance sought in CO, IN, KY, MI
- School testing requirements under discussion in IL, PA

State Rn program contracts with IEA for desk-audits of measurement professionals and/or site inspections of mitigation systems

### **State Program provides:**

- List of <u>property owners</u> to solicit, or a confirmed list of those interested
- List of measurement professionals to be audited

### **IEA Mitigation Inspections include:**

Onsite inspection with photos using phone app

Summary report and recommendations

### **IEA Measurement Desk Audits include:**

- QAP review
- Review of 3 test reports
- Summary report and recommendations





- March 10 well-attended Radon Stakeholder
  Conference, Chicago; hybrid event recorded.
- June 16 Hosted IEMA listening session in Chicago, an opportunity for Radon Mitigators Measurement and Labs to give feedback on proposed rule change.
- August 1 Illinois Governor Signed the Radon Tenant Bill, similar to the Buyers Awareness Act, affecting 3.5 million tenants in IL - a Midwest initiative.
- August 9 Formally affiliated with National AARST
  2024
- · March 15: Radon Stakeholder Conference, Chicago
- School bill requires testing and mitigations in all public schools, currently has 28 co-sponsors (Senators and Reps) –to be presented in the fall session.


