

- Each household tested is given an informational Leech Lake Radon Program tri-fold.




WHY IS RADON DANGEROUS?

Radon is responsible for 21,000 lung cancer deaths per year.







WHAT IS RADON?

- Radon is a naturally occurring gas in the soil and can be found almost everywhere.
- Your greatest exposure is where radon can concentrate, inside your home.
- You cannot see, smell or taste radon.
- Radon can cause lung cancer and has no symptoms.
- Radon is the 2nd leading cause of lung cancer with 21,000 deaths per year.
- The healthiest people can get lung cancer from radon. If you smoke, your risk is 4 times greater.
- Living in a home with 4 pCi/L over 12 years is equal to smoking 10 packs of cigarettes per day.
- There is no known safe level of radon.

DOES MY HOUSE HAVE HIGH LEVELS OF RADON?

The ONLY WAY to find out is to TEST YOUR HOME.

- The average indoor level is 1.3 pCi/L, outdoor is 0.4 pCi/L.
- In Minnesota, 2 in 5 homes have radon issues.
- Minnesota's geology produces a natural supply of radon that can build up in your home.
- Radon levels as high as 44 pCi/L have been measured on the Leech Lake Reservation.

PROTECT, PREVENT, TEST!

The Leech Lake Radon Program uses the World Health Organization action level of 2.7 pCi/L instead of EPA's 4.0 pCi/L level. This means if your radon levels are 2.7 or higher, there is a health concern that needs to be addressed.

TEST YOUR HOME!

Old or new, drafty or well sealed, with or without a basement or crawl space... ALL HOMES need to be tested!

We offer 1 free test kit per household.

Short term test: 3-7 days Long term test: 90 days -1 year


MY RADON TEST SAYS I HAVE HIGH RADON LEVELS. WHAT CAN I DO?

- Your home is fixable. A radon mitigation system can be installed in your home to divert the harmful gas.
- These systems act as a vacuum that sucks the radon out from under your home's foundation.
- These systems work 24/7 to keep radon out of your home and costs less than \$2 per month to run!
- The Leech Lake Radon Program is here to provide information and technical assistance to homeowners.

- Tell your family & friends to test their homes.
- Fix your home if it has high levels of radon.
