# Program Focuses

Our focus is on education and outreach within Alabama communities

# Successes

- Radon Action and Lung Awareness Months typically deplete our supply of free short-term radon kits.
- Currently, we have 60 libraries participating in the library lending program using the EcoBlu continuous radon monitors
- 7 libraries have requested a radon presentation. 4 out of the 7 have been completed since the start of the program this year





# Challenges

- A small number of free radon tests are being used after receipt.
- There are no statewide radon laws, such as mandatory Radon-Resistant New Construction (RRNC) or state-issued certification requirements for measurement and mitigation professionals.
