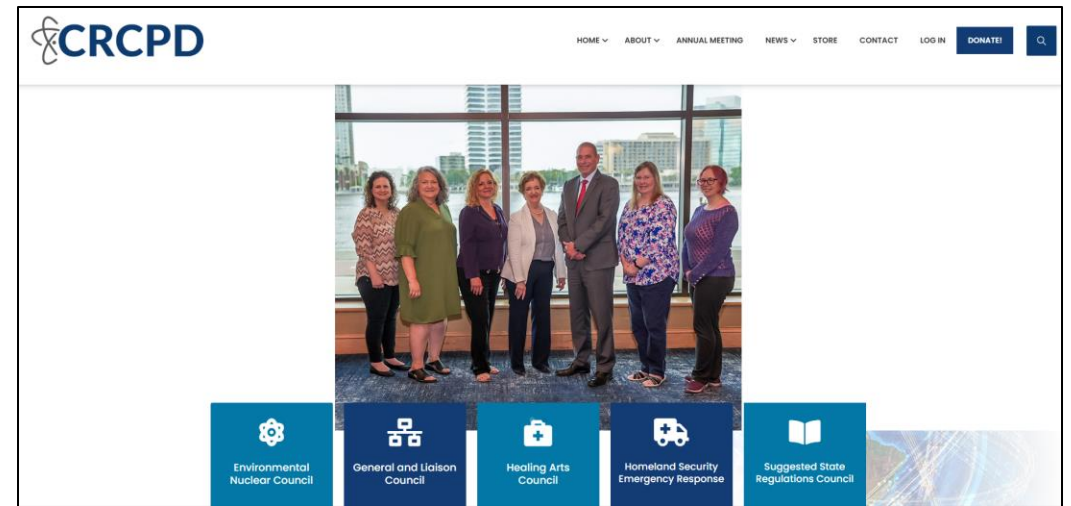

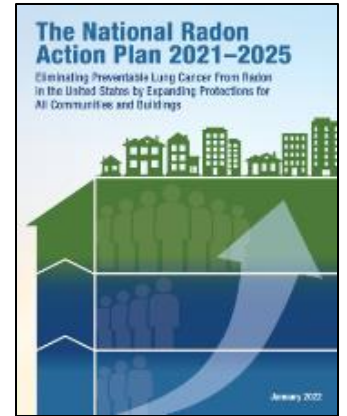
501(c)(3) nonprofit non-governmental professional organization dedicated to radiation protection.

3. To provide liaison for CRCPD with the American Association of Radon Scientists and Technologists (AARST). [G5 - O1, O2, O3]
4. Develop and provide technical training to support state radon activities in conjunction with the National Radon Training Event, and as needed. [G3-O1, O3]
5. Coordinate the judging of the National Radon Poster and Video Contest. [G2 – O2] [G5 –O2]

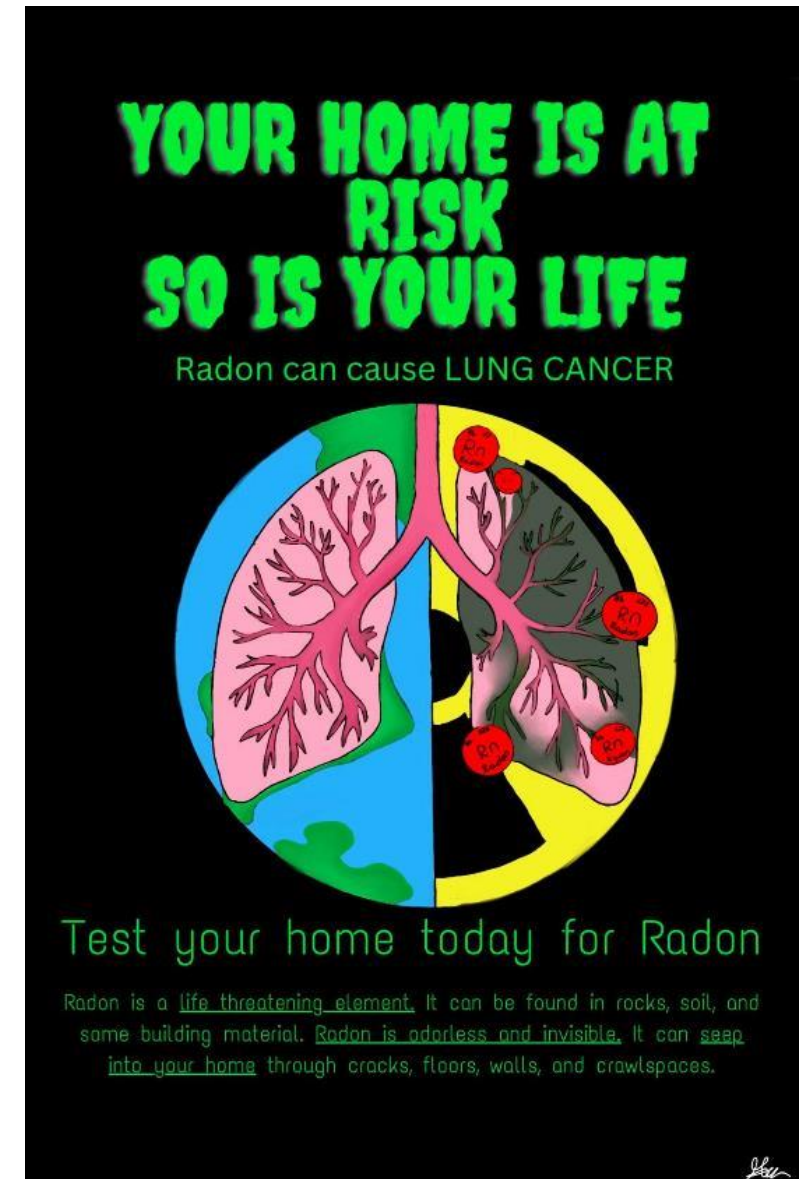

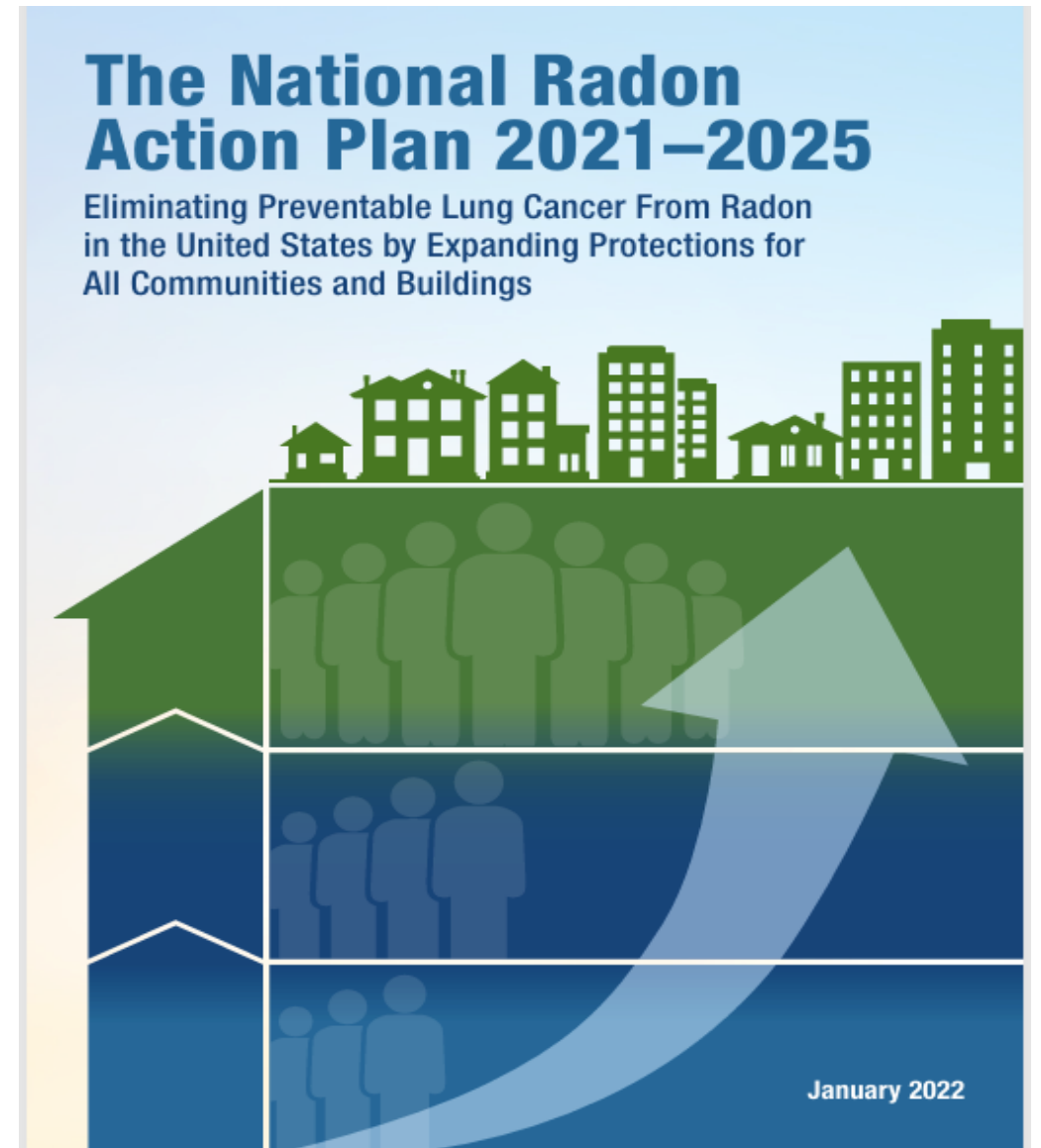

Working group established to develop a consumer guide for continuous digital radon monitors (CDRM's).

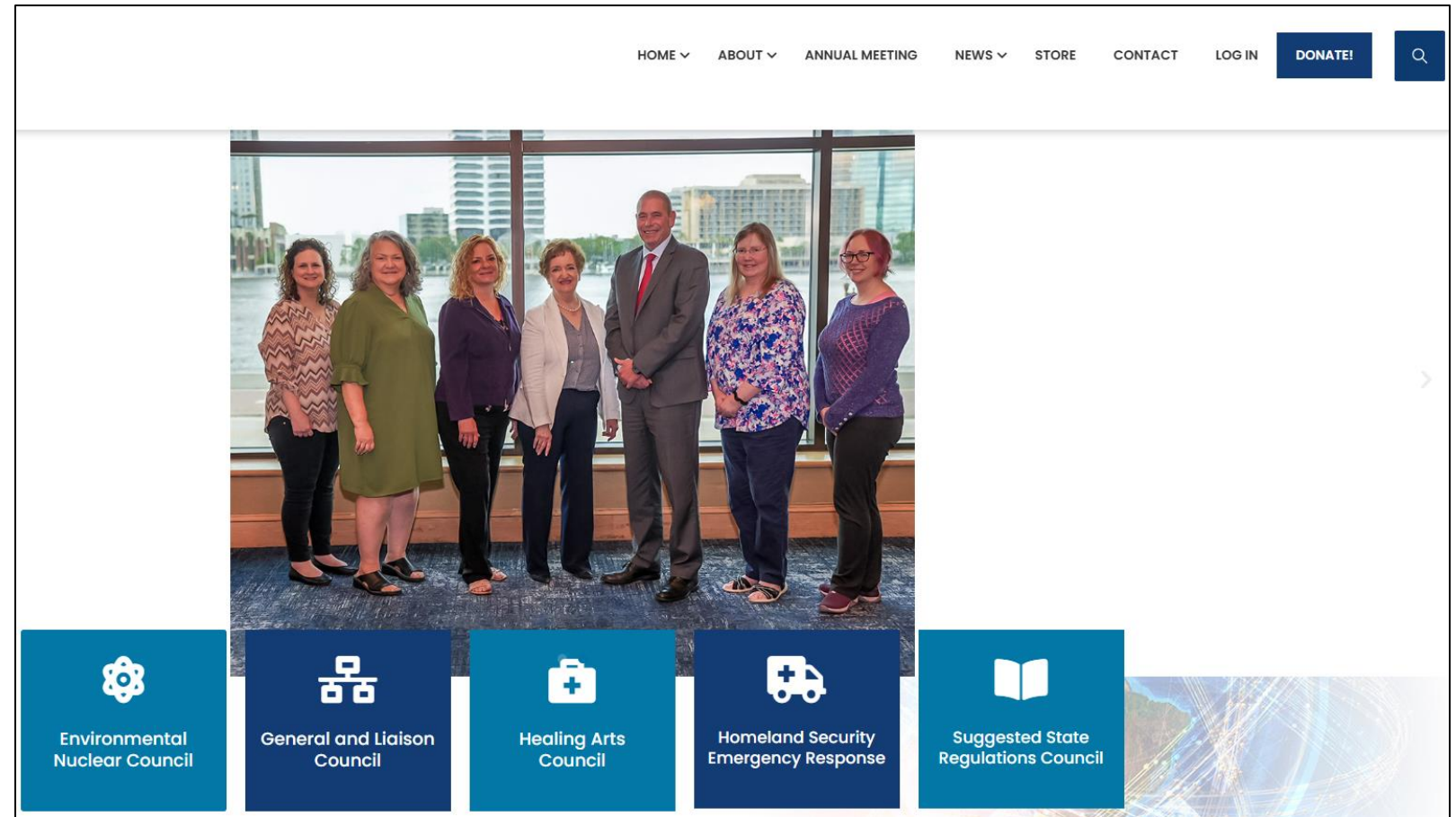
