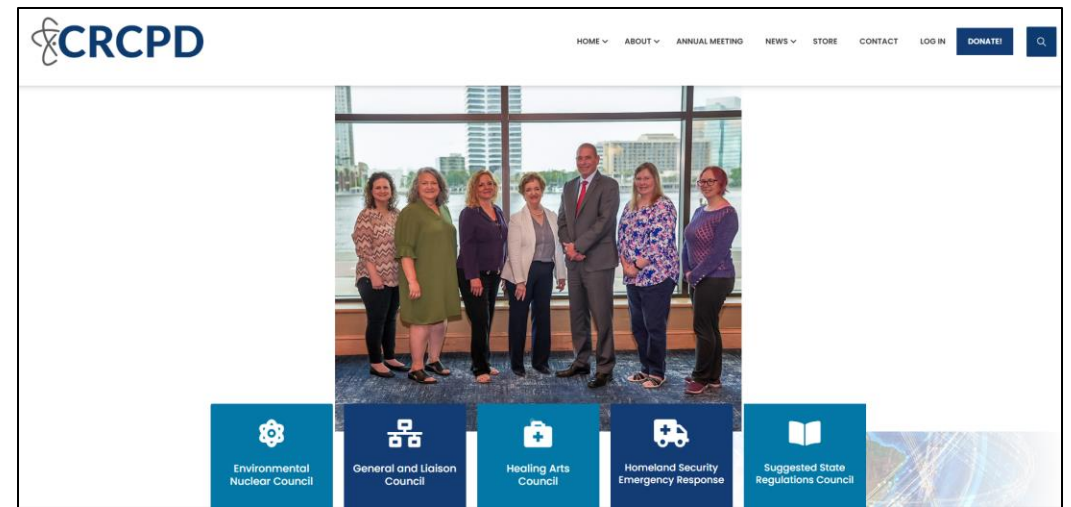

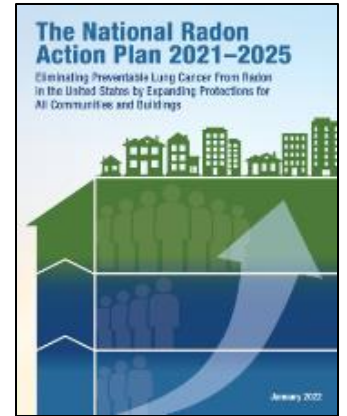
**501(c)(3) nonprofit non-governmental professional organization dedicated to radiation protection.**

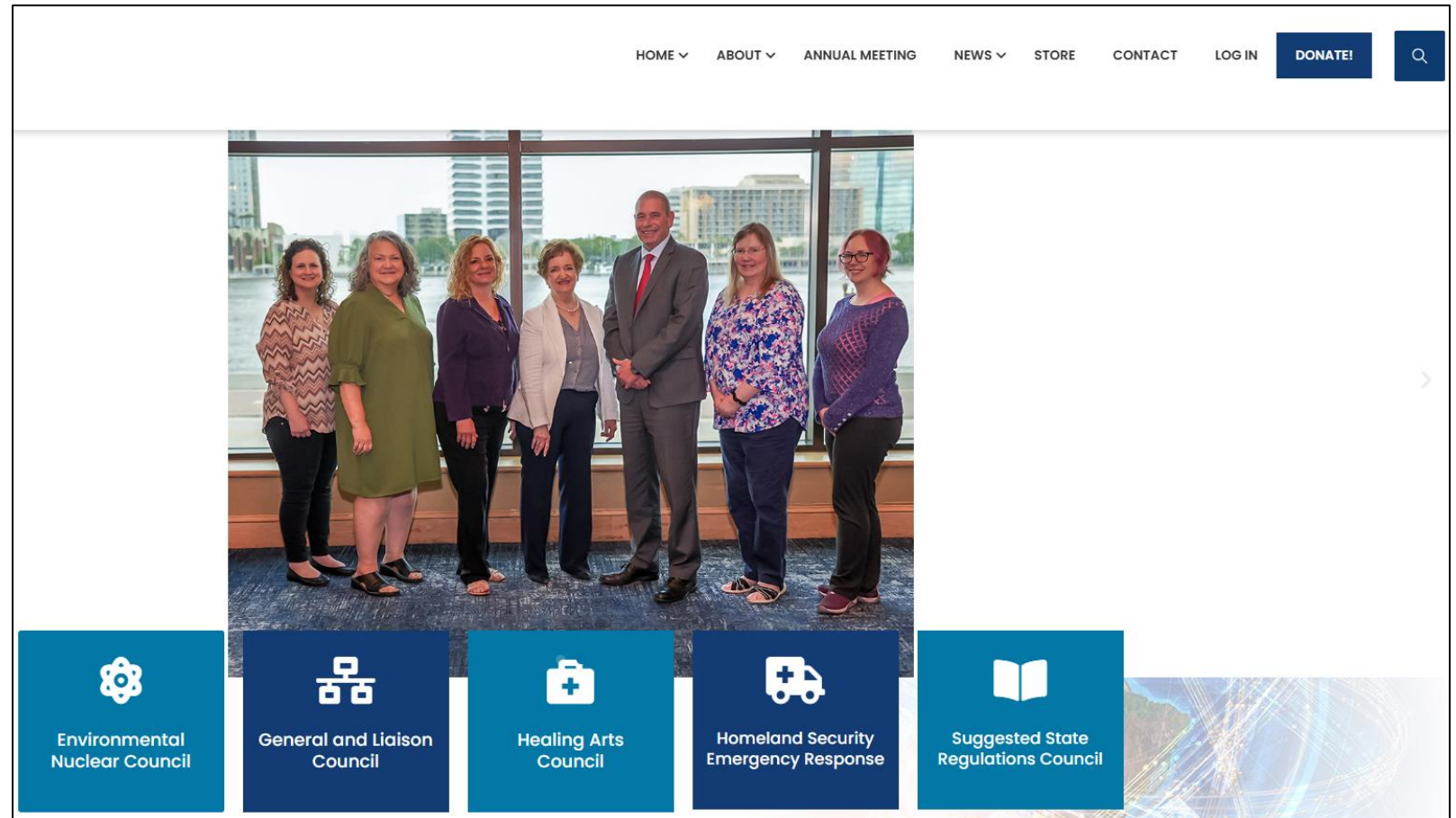
### The Radon Appendix in the International Radon Code

- International Residential Code (IRC) created Appendix F 1993-1995
- Numerous state / local jurisdictions have adopted it
- Unchanged since 1995 - except
  - addition of the testing requirement effective 2021
- Appendix **F** renamed **Appendix AF** in 2021
- Appendix **AF** renamed **Appendix BE** in the 2024 code.
