Radon in Colorado

- 50% of homes test above the EPA Action Level (4 pCi/L)
- Low Income Radon Mitigation Assistance Program
- State license & certification requirement for radon professionals

HB21-1195

Regulation Of Radon Professionals

Concerning the regulation of radon professionals, and, in connection therewith, requiring licensure to practice as a radon measurement professional or radon mitigation professional, and making an appropriation.

SESSION: 2021 Regular Session

As of July 2022, all Radon Measurement & Mitigation Professionals should be certified *and* licensed to operate in Colorado

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add article 165 to title 12 as follows:

ARTICLE 165 **Radon Professionals**

12-165-101. Short title. THE SHORT TITLE OF THIS ARTICLE 165 IS THE "RADON MEASUREMENT AND MITIGATION LICENSING ACT".

12-165-102. Legislative declaration. THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

New Program Growing Pains: Enforcement & Subject Matter Expertise

The Office of Radon Professionals is housed in the Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA)

Time Frame	Notices of Violation Issued	Cease & Desist Orders Issued
Oct. 2022 - Mar. 2023	36	2
Apr. 2023 - Sept. 2023	0	2

- Radon-resistant new construction implementation

What's working well?

Low Income Radon Mitigation Assistance

- State funding for radon mitigation assistance to qualified homeowners
- First LIRMA mitigation jobs began in early 2018



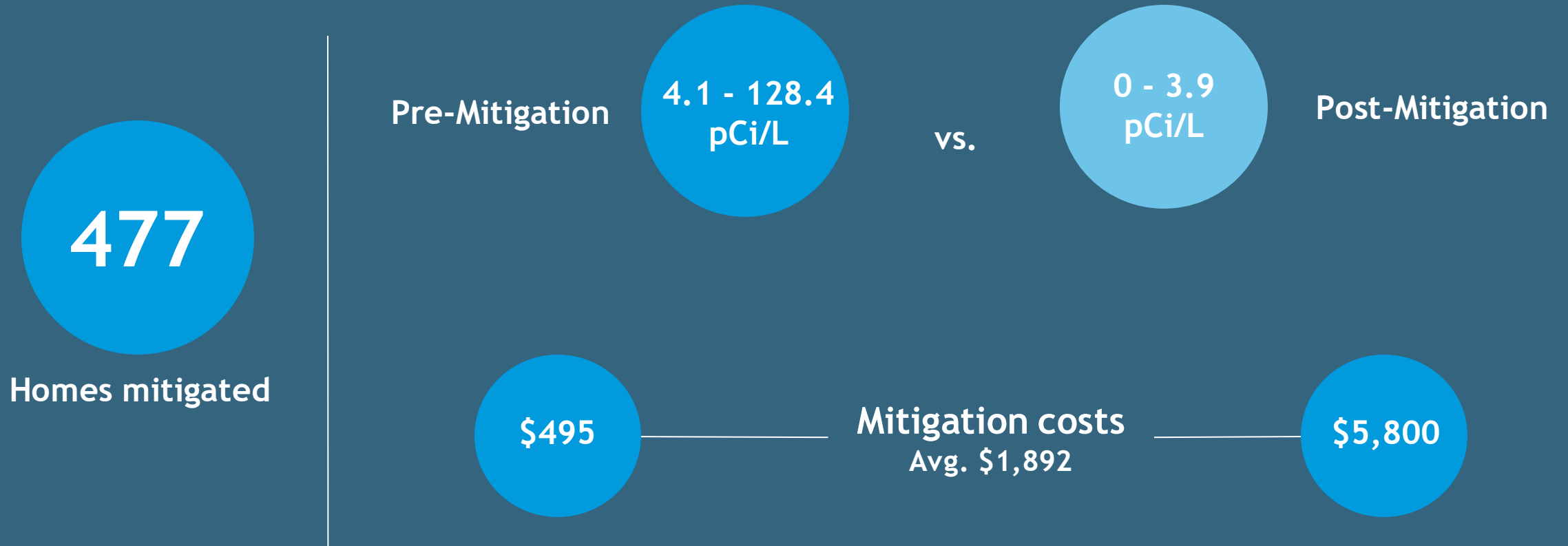
If your home has high radon levels and you meet certain income requirements, you may qualify for a free radon mitigation system through the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE).

Low Income Radon Mitigation Assistance

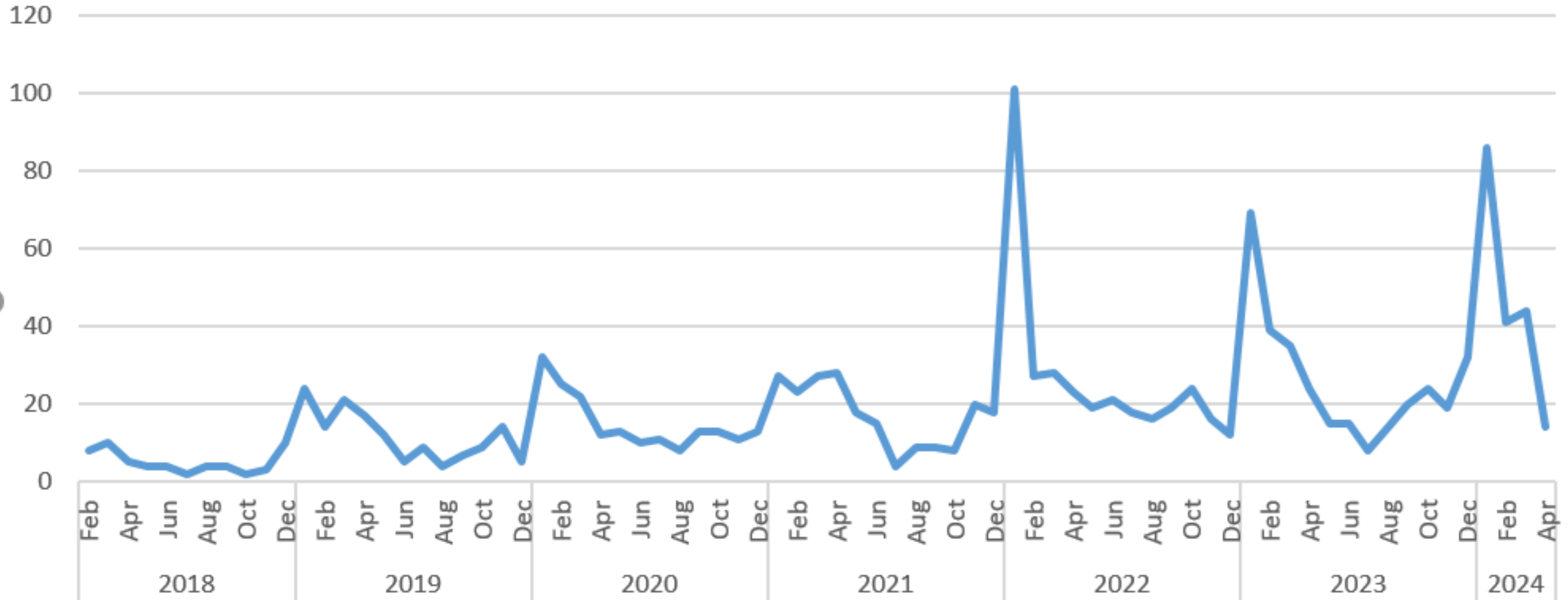
- State FY 2024 – LIRMA received additional funding
 - Due to successful program implementation, cost-benefit justifications, and rave reviews from past participants.
- Additional funding was used to expand marketing & free radon test kit availability
 - 13k test kits distributed
 - More applications in 2024 than any prior YTD
